If it is later determined that offsets have to be made because of any depletions to the river caused by the appeal, whatever offsets have to be made will be the landowner's responsibility.

Land traded and returned to dryland acres will be spot checked to verify that it remains dryland.

Penalties: If it is determined by the NRD that any of the acres that were agreed upon to remain dryland are irrigated, a Cease & Desist Order (SS46-707) may be issued. Penalties could include not less than \$1,000 - \$5,000 per day (SS46-745) fine.
