ELIGIBILITY – To be eligible, an applicant must satisfy the following requirements:

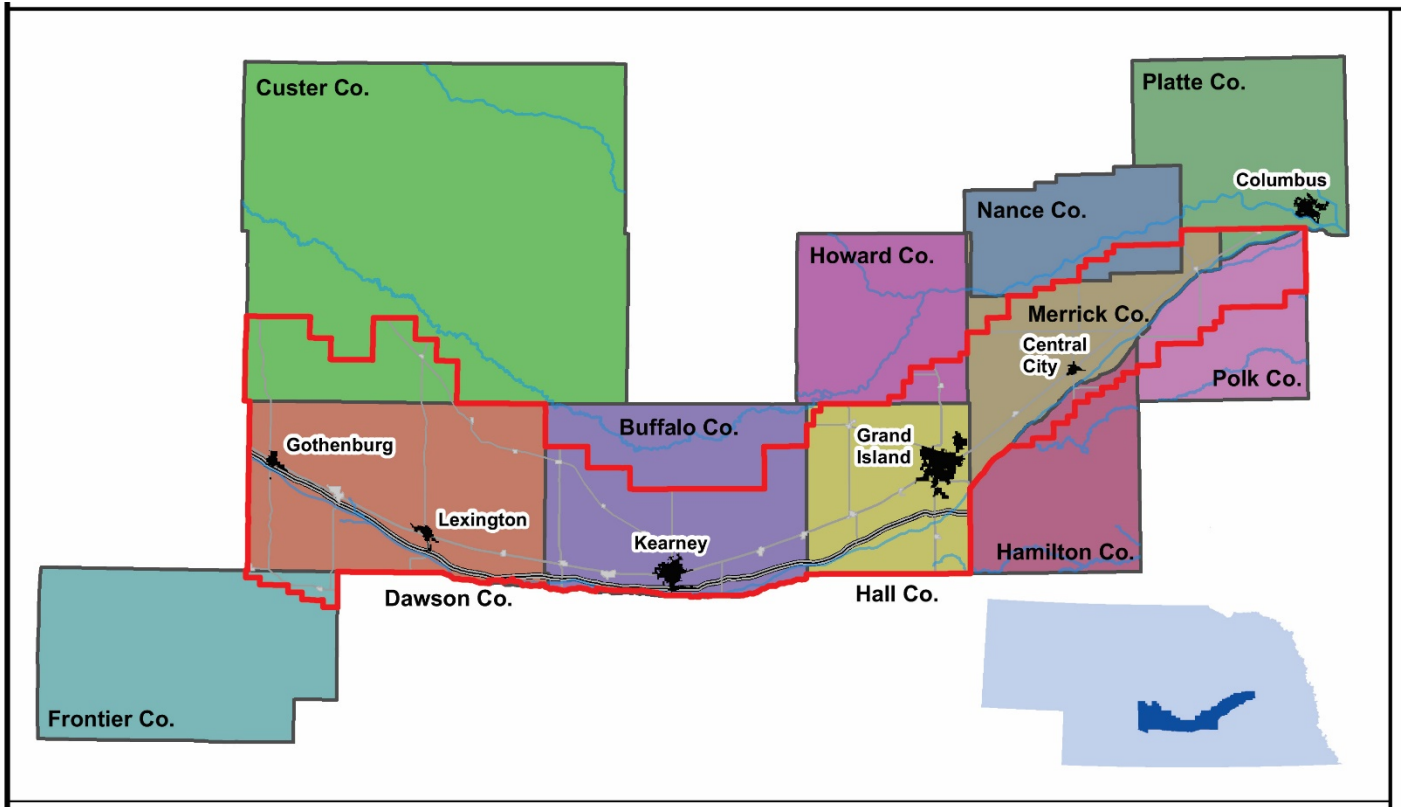
1. Applicant must be a resident of the Central Platte Natural Resources District (*see Map on Page 2 of this application*).
